

## **Krabbendam and Tucson Water collaborate on talk**

In conjunction with Architecture Week, several Tucson architects will be providing free presentations on various topics at various public libraries around town. One such talk is "Architecture and Water: Exploring Innovating Designs" with Roel Krabbendam, senior architect at ABA Architects, and Tucson Water's Ilene Grossman. As buildings relate to water in deep and varied ways, Krabbendam draws from recent trips to Europe and Africa, and Grossman will discuss Tucson projects to illustrate past and present examples of the relationships between architecture and water.
